- b. Demonstrated scientific interest, research and academic rigor in the field of nature conservation.
- c. Enhancing the identity of Nepal at the national and international level, through the demonstration of his/her talent and work in the field of nature conservation.
- d. Made significant contributions or played a leadership role in accomplishing the programs relevant to the Trust's mission and vision or played a leadership role in developing policy and operational reforms to the conservation and sustainability agenda of Nepal.
