Call for Expression of Intent (Eol): Adaptation Fund Project/Programme Proposals

The Government of Nepal, Ministry of Agriculture, Forests and Environment (MoAFE), has published a 15-day notice dated 6 Ashoj 2083 calling for Letters of Intent (Eol) to submit project/programme proposals to the Adaptation Fund.

In reference to that notice, the National Trust for Nature Conservation (NTNC), an accredited National Implementing Entity (NIE) of the Adaptation Fund, invites legally registered organizations in Nepal to submit Eols for climate change adaptation project concepts to be developed and submitted through NTNC. Consortium applications are welcome. Proposed concepts must address national climate adaptation priorities and be aligned with Nepal's national policies and plans, including the National Climate Change Policy, the National Adaptation Plan (NAP), the Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC), and relevant provincial and local adaptation plans.

The Eol should include:

1. Project title and applicant organization profile
2. Proposed location (Province, District and Local Government)
3. Climate problem and justification
4. Alignment with national priorities, policies and plans
5. Proposed adaptation interventions
6. Target beneficiaries (estimated households/people)
7. Expected climate resilience outcomes
8. Indicative budget and implementation period
9. Contact person and details

Submission: Email the EOI to **climate@ntnc.org.np** with the subject line "Eol – Adaptation Fund – [Organization Name]" by **5:00 PM on 2 October 2026 (16 Ashoj 2083)**.

NTNC will review the Eols and forward the selected concepts to MoAFE in line with the Government notice. Only shortlisted organizations will be contacted. NTNC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all submissions without assigning any reason.
